Use **doesn't** with one person or thing.

Examples: Joe **doesn't** read very well.

He **doesn't** ride the bus.

Use **don't** with more than one person or thing.

Examples: They **don't** come on time.

Ted and Leo **don't** have bags.

Use **don't** with **I**, **You** and **We**.

Examples: I **don't** like to be late.

You **don't** throw wrappers around.

We **don't** shout at others.
