- What are you doing these days?

- Are you enjoying it?

- I'm trying / I am trying
- I'm decorating / I am decorating

* Present Continuous

- I + **am (I'm)** + (verb)-**ing**
- he/she/it + **is (he's etc.)** + (verb)-**ing**
- we/you/they + **are (we're etc.)** + (verb)-**ing**
