### **SOME OR ANY?**

## **Countable Nouns:**



Affirmative: There are **some** apples.

Negative: There aren't **any** apples.

Interrogative: Are there **any** apples?

# **Uncountable Nouns:**



Affirmative: There is <u>some</u> water
Negative: There isn't <u>any</u> water.
Interrogative: Is there <u>any</u> water?

### **REMEMBER:**

Use some in affirmative sentences Use any in negative sentences Use any in interrogative sentences or questions.
