

SOME OR ANY?

Countable Nouns:



Affirmative: There are **some** apples.
Negative: There aren't **any** apples.
Interrogative: Are there **any** apples?

Uncountable Nouns:



Affirmative: There is **some** water
Negative: There isn't **any** water.
Interrogative: Is there **any** water?

Use any in negative sentences
Use any in interrogative sentences or questions.
