SIX MORE MONTHS TO LIVE (advance 4)

The doctor has bad news for you: according to him, you only have six more months to live. Most of that time, you will not be bed-ridden, and the pain will be minimal as long as you take your medicine. But recovery is all but impossible.

VOCABULARY:

bed-ridden- Confined to bed because of illness or infirmity.

recovery - gradual healing (through rest) after sickness or injury **fatal-** causing or capable of causing death
