

Use of this/these and that/those

Dialogue:

1. What is this?
This is my book.
2. What are these?
These are his books.
3. What is that?
That is her pencil.
4. What are those?
Those are all their toys.

Note:

Near to the speaker: This--- used for singular object.

These---used for plural objects.

Far to the speaker: That--- singular object

Those--- plural objects

Practices:

1. [this, that] is my new doll. (Insert picture of a girl with her doll in her arms.)
2. [this, that] is her English book. (Insert picture of a girl carrying a book.)
3. [these, those] are my pets. (A boy pointing the pets in the garden.)
4. [these, those] are their coloring materials. (A pupil pointing all the coloring materials on top of the desk of the teacher.)
