## Dialogue:

What is this?
This is my book.

2. What are these?

These are his books.

What is that? That is her pencil.

What are those? Those are all their toys.

## Note:

Near to the speaker: This--- used for singular object.

These---used for plural objects.

Far to the speaker: That--- singular object

Those--- plural objects
