

Kinds of sentences:

Analyze the following sentences:

1. She gave me a wonderful gift on my birthday.
2. May I borrow your book?
3. Yahoo! I got the first prize.
4. Mark, kindly get me a glass of water?

Notes:

- Declarative --- sentence which tells or states something. [Ends with a period (.)]

Ex: My parents were happy to see you.

- Interrogative ----- sentence that asks something.[ends with a question mark (?)]

Ex: What are you doing there?

- Imperative ---- sentence which gives command or order. [Uses period (.)]

Ex: Cathy, please remove the curtain in your room.

- Exclamatory --- sentence which shows strong feelings.[ends with a exclamation point. (!)]

Ex: Opss! You're stepping on my toes.
